- Minutes from the May 31, 2013 meeting were approved.
- Old Business
 - Jendy provided an update on Zinio at APL. Some obstacles include glitches with Zinio and staff training. Marketing efforts include labeling printed materials and providing bookmarks with information about the Zinio service.
- New Business
 - Question from DA regarding the procedure for HarperCollins items that reach their checkout limit.
 - The Central Library manages HarperCollins titles that reach the checkout limit. Jendy will follow up with the committee with information about the procedure regarding purchasing copies of HarperCollins titles that expire.
 - JoAnn provided the committee with updates from Digitalozza. Some of the highlights are below:
 - OMC v3 will be available August 20.
 - Streaming video is coming later this year (streaming from 3-letter cable stations, our current digital video content and feature films)
 - Streaming audiobooks and music is coming in 2014
 - The effectiveness of using Central Library funds to purchase advantage titles for each library was discussed. Some titles can only be purchased through Advantage. It was agreed that it would not be cost effective since each member library will need an Advantage account.
 - Jendy shared her experience using Collection HQ. The reports are helpful to manage the collection, especially for a library with multiple branches. The reports provide more detailed information such as cost/circ.
